- workshop supports the Friday Night Live Standards of Practice

Workshops should focus on sharing projects, initiatives and campaigns that the presenters have implemented with their chapters/youth councils. Workshop audiences should come away with a clear understanding of why the project was chosen, processes used to implement it and how it could be replicated in their communities. Hand outs should be oriented to participant replication of the projects.

We encourage youth and adult partnerships in the design and preparation of the presentation.. Workshops are scheduled to be one hour and fifteen minutes long, and may be repeated.

If your team is selected, you will be expected to agree and adhere to the training requirements and time line/dates. As a presenter, **you are still a Summit participant. As such, you are expected to fully participate in all planned conference activities.**
