

# Alcoholic Energy Drinks

## Ingredients:

Ginseng  
Guarana  
Ginko  
Glucuronolactone  
Taurine  
Also contains caffeine and other stimulants, plus alcohol



## Alcohol Content: 6% - 9.9%

*That is more alcohol than you would find in beer and roughly the same amount of alcohol found in wine.*

## The Problem:

- Alcoholic energy drinks are packaged in cans that usually look similar to non-alcoholic energy drinks
- Alcohol content is not clearly shown on many of the alcoholic energy drinks
- These drinks are usually located in stores near the non-alcoholic energy drinks and sodas
- Due to the deceiving packaging and it's location in stores, people might accidentally buy and alcoholic one, youth can purchase the alcoholic type more easily, and students can even get away with drinking them in school or during a school event
- The mixture of a depressant (alcohol) and a stimulant (caffeine) can lead to serious health issues
- The dangerous mixture will create an "awake drunk", which will cause people to feel like they're not drunk and in turn, they might continue to drink, or they might drive under the influence
